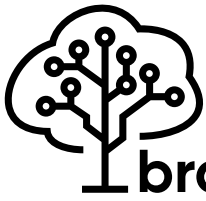
Background on Xilva AG:

- Creating solid and trustworthy relations with the developers of the relevant forests projects in order to collect their relevant information into digital databases.
- Design a database of forest projects in collaboration with the Digital Team of the Marketplace.

Requirements for the position
